#### **Overview:**

On June 30th, 2022, the Knowledge and Awareness Mapping Platform (KAMP) organized the 12th episode of its series "Achievers - Leaders of Tomorrow," hosted by Mr. Aniket Arora. This episode was conducted online, and the recordings will also be aired on their YouTube channel.





KAMP is an initiative and knowledge alliance of CSIR-NIScPR and NCPL. The main objective of KAMP is to map the science process skills and scientific attitudes of young students based on their assessment and nurture them as future scientists in the country. KAMP believes that every student is blessed with a core talent and seeks to bring out the best in them through this platform. With

this, they aim to inculcate critical thinking ability within them and fill in the gaps that prevent them from achieving their highest potential.

"Achievers: The Leaders of Tomorrow" is a series that aims to inspire students to be creative, discover their true potential, be inspired by great things in life, and help develop the nation through their unique ideas. For this episode, KAMP invited a young achiever named Miss Prasiddhi Singh, a 10-year-old Environmental Conservationist in India. She has received many awards for her achievements, including the Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar 2021, which

is the highest award in India given to civilians up to the age of 18.

Prasiddhi is an inspiring environmental conservationist, dedicated to preserving our world's natural resources. Set on a mission to conserve and protect our planet. She works hard to ensure that natural habitats are maintained and that future generations can experience the same beauty of wildlife that we enjoy today.



She started with environmental activism in 2016 after Cyclone Vardah uprooted trees in her neighbourhood and destroyed villages and farmlands. Currently, she is the founder of the Prasiddhi Forest Foundation, which intends to improve the planet by increasing green cover and encouraging recycling.



To date, the Prasiddhi Foundation has collected over 150,000 seeds and created 28 microforests. Last year, by December 2022, she had achieved her mission of planting 1 lakh trees. She is now on a mission to spread environmental awareness to every school and every student in India.

With more than 250 participants, this episode of "Achievers - The Leaders of Tomorrow" was graced by the presence of Prof. Dhar, Chairman of - the KAMP Planning and Monitoring Committee, Mr. Ashish Mittal, Member of the KAMP Planning and Monitoring Committee; and Ms. Arika Mathur, Member of the KAMP Planning and Monitoring Committee. Prof. Dhar has always been supportive of the Achiever's initiative, he loves to interact with the young Achiever as well as other students in the audience filled with curiosity.



Overall, the interactive session with Ms Prasiddhi Singh was an incredible one. We had quite an enthusiastic audience, who were given a chance to ask direct questions to Prasiddhi. Our audience came up with several questions related to Prasiddhi's achievements, interests, inspirations, experience, journey to success, her NGO, or how to contribute to the environment as an individual.
