For her distinguished accomplishments, she has also won many prestigious awards like the Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar 2021, the Diana Award 2021, Global Child Prodigy Award 2022, and is the youngest recipient of the Global E-Innovation Award 2019.
