

success in their careers. In this dynamic and ever-changing world, it is crucial to equip oneself with the right tools and knowledge to thrive in a professional journey.

The session was convened by Mr. Aniket Arora, and facilitated by Mr. Tushar Parekh, (Vice




President of the Allen Career Institute). He has been academician for more than 33 years and is a National Prodigy mentor. He is the key person to developing the arade 6–10 division and establishing the prodigy department at Allen.

In this workshop, Mr. Parekh guided the students on career options within the country as well as overseas. He mentioned that it is essential for

students to start focusing on vocational courses right after 10th grade. He further added that for students after 12th grade, it becomes essential to start seeking professional courses within their

interests. It is the right time when the students should have a good understanding of what they want to be and what path they should be taking in order to achieve that goal.

It is important for students to identify their skills right from the beginning, and based on that, they should start making strategies for choosing their career and getting as much practical exposure



as they can for it. Mr. Parekh pointed out that in today's world, thousands and lakhs of individuals want to do a job, but none of them leader want to be а entrepreneur. Thus, it is important for students to build up their personalities from an early age, making it convenient for them to have limitless possibilities and opportunities in their desired fields. He adds that having certain skills critical thinking, like decision

making, logical thinking, problem solving, observation, etc. can help us build a better character for ourselves that can be suitable in any occupation.

In our country, students have a choice of careers within the science stream; Engineering, Medical, Pure Science, Research & Mathematics, Marine, Navy & Defence etc. While for the Non-Science Stream, they have a career choice within the fields of Law, CA-CS, Management, Fashion and Design, humanities & Social Sciences, languages, etc. After choosing the stream based on their skills, students must be aware of the possibilities within the career choice they are making, and

what entrance exams need to be given to maximize their outcome, how they could prepare, the eligibility criteria, and the number of seats for the selected candidates.

KAMP's fortnightly workshops help students develop creativity, meaningful learning, and critical reading and thinking skills that bring out their inherent abilities. The vision of KAMP is to identify and capture scientific and technological



temperaments in students to make India a global leader in science, technology, and the humanities.
