On August 19th, 2023, KAMP conducted its 33rd exclusive knowledge-sharing session on the



The main aim of this workshop was to allow the students to explore descriptive writing techniques. The session was convened by Mr. Aniket Arora and facilitated by Mr. Souhardya De (PM-YUVA Author).

During this engaging workshop, Mr. Souhardya undertook the task of unraveling the art of descriptive writing for eager students.



Descriptive writing, as he elaborated, is a unique form of literary expression that revolves around the meticulous detailing of people, places, objects, events, or even emotions. It transcends mere storytelling; its primary objective is to transport readers into a world where they can vividly


perceive and emotionally connect with the subject matter.



The essence of descriptive writing in its ability to create a lies multisensory and immersive experience. By skillfully employing words, it triggers the reader's senses. evokes their emotions, and stimulates their imagination. In doing so, it breathes life into the text, making it a living, breathing entity in the reader's mind.

Mr. Souhardya's insights didn't stop at the mechanics of descriptive writing. He ventured further

into the realm of expressive writing. emphasizing importance of cultivating a heightened expressive capacity. He encouraged students to remain attuned to their surroundings, drawing inspiration from the world around them. This. he emphasized, is the cornerstone of becoming a successful writer.



In addition, Mr. Souhardya

shed light on the significance of maintaining a continuous flow of creativity and inspiration. To achieve this, he advocated a three-pronged approach. Firstly, he urged students to be observant and aware of their environment, recognizing that inspiration often lurks in the mundane. Secondly, he championed the habit of diverse reading, as exposure to a variety of writing styles and themes



fuels one's creative reservoir. Lastly, he encouraged students to incorporate vivid and expressive language into their daily conversations, thereby honing their wordcraft and fostering an innate aptitude for descriptive writing.

Writing is a versatile art, and its many forms offer a rich tapestry of expression. Each form comes with its unique characteristics, formats, and jargon. In this session, Mr Souhardya embarked

on a brief journey through some diverse forms of writings, like Poetry, essays, Novel-writing, screenwriting, creative writing, Genre mashup & Experimentation, fictional novels & Fantasy Novels, Historical Fiction and Haiku & Japanese Poetry, etc.

It is important for students to understand that creativity is a journey, not a destination. They must embrace their unique voices and storytelling style, and with practice and dedication, they can become skilled and imaginative creative writers. Mr. Souhardya suggested various tips for becoming a creative writer like setting aside dedicated time daily or weekly, even if it's just for a

short burst of creativity; reading widely across genres and authors, as exposure to diverse styles and perspectives can inspire their creativity; Keeping a notebook or digital tool for jotting down ideas, phrases, or observations that strike you throughout the day. etc.

In this digital age in particular, you have the opportunity to share your thoughts, experiences, and creativity with a global audience. Platforms like Substack, LinkedIn newsletters, Scroll Stack, and Wattpad offer avenues to showcase your creative narratives and connect with readers who love immersive storytelling. Consistency is key.



In essence, Mr. Souhardya's workshop was more than a lesson in descriptive writing; it was a journey into the art of crafting words that resonate deeply with readers. His guidance not only unveiled the mechanics but also instilled in students the passion, curiosity, and observant eye required to become proficient and accomplished writers.
